Mission Statement

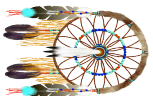
To eliminate the existence of chemical dependency through the application of Biblical principles while maintaining the cultural integrity of its participants.

At Navajo BIC Overcomers we strive to fulfill the vision to provide a ministry of reconciliation for Native American families by promoting healing—spiritually, emotionally, physically, mentally and relationally. We present this message in a professional counseling setting and with sound Biblical content within the context of the Native American culture. We encourage the men to get to know the character of God and who He created them to be. It is out of this identity and the grace of God that we can overcome the bondage of addiction

How You Can Help

- We cannot enjoy a 70% success rate with these men without the support of the body. It is by your prayers that God releases His Spirit within the program to change lives. There are also physical needs that must be met. The Overcomers Program is run entirely off the financial support of individuals. The Program Director's family must also raise their own financial support. Here is a list of some of the needs:

We Provide

- ◆ Three month intensive residential program
- ◆ Three month aftercare phase
- ◆ Outpatient counseling
- ◆ Overcomers support group

Typical Week

Each morning begins with a time of Praise & Worship around the drum.



Classes include:

- * Creation to Christ—A comprehensive study of the Bible.
- * Navajo Reading—Understanding of the Navajo written language.
- * Nutrition—Benefits of healthy eating habits.
- * Inner Healing—Deals with the psychological and emotional aspects of addiction.
- * Wild at heart—Who we are in Christ.
- * Personal Finances—Being good stewards of that which God gives us.
- * Broken Walls Fellowship—Church service that meets every Saturday evening.
- * Life Skills—Learning people skills.
- * Community work projects—Allowing the men to give back to the community.
- * Convicted By Christ—Men's accountability group at World Harvest Church.

The BIC Overcomers is an intensive 90-day residential rehab program. After graduation from our program, each client is required to participate in three months of aftercare. We work primarily, but not entirely, with Navajo men who have succumbed to the ravages of addiction to alcohol, drugs or other self-destructive behavior. Our methods include a clinical approach, educating the clients on the detrimental effects of drugs and alcohol on body and soul, along with how one can become chemically and emotionally dependent. The clinical is enhanced by a Christ-centered approach, within the context of Navajo culture, dealing with all things spiritual.

We house up to eight men, twice a year, in our facility on the campus of Navajo BIC Mission near Nageezi, NM. We try to supply whatever is needed to provide a quality atmosphere so that our clients can focus on recovery. Our curriculum consist of individual counseling, group therapy, Bible study, financial planning, computer basics, family dynamics and responsibility awareness. Each week we have Family Support Day for parent, spouse or significant other to be involved in classes with their family member. Weekly phone calls and visits encourage family to stay involved in the recovery process of each client. We provide a home-style atmosphere that allows them the opportunity to concentrate on their emotional, physical, spiritual and mental healing through the various daily classes.
