Greetings from the high desert.

To begin with we want to express our heartfelt thanks to all our supporters, as we were immensely blessed while we were on our trip this past December. We have currently raised nearly \$100,000 towards our goal. We had to again cancel a program for this spring due to the Covid restrictions in this state. This does not mean that we will be idle this year. We are partnering with many varying ministries in Farmington with the purpose of reaching into the streets and the community while remaining open to God's direction for Hope & Redemption Ranch. We will be volunteering for 5 weeks at

Byron's House of Hope—a men's transition home—June 12 to July 19. We are also working with Nat'l disaster relief and the red cross.

As we had mentioned to many while we were on the road, we need to be off the property by the end of the year. This created a housing need that we didn't know for sure how it was going to be filled. God opened up an amazing opportunity as one of our board members, Marylou NezBegy, graciously offered us a trailer that we can use and possibly purchase down the road for the ranch. It is a 16 X 80 single wide 3 bedroom located in Crouch Mesa which is between Farmington & Bloomfield.

Marylou's brother was in the process of remodeling when he passed away 1 1/2 yrs. ago. The trailer has been vandalized, all the windows have been broken and some interior damages, but is fixable and would provide us the housing we need. As always God provides when a need arises. We are looking for Churches or individuals willing to make a ministry trip to help us with repairs as we want to be off the mission grounds by the end of summer. We ask that you make this an issue of prayer and let us know.

1. Replace windows (9)
2. Replace entry door
3. Repair skirting
4. Roof seal
5. Landscaping

Bed 1 & 2, Bath, Hallway:

1. Bedroom doors (2)
2. Install medicine cabinet.
3. Replace tub surround.
4. Wall repair & paint.
5. Light fixtures.

Living Room:

1. Finish flooring.
2. Wall repair & paint.
3. Ceiling fan installation.

Kitchen & Laundry area:

1. Flooring (220 ft²).
2. Wall repair & paint.
3. Cabinet repair.
4. Replace oven.

5. Refrigerator
6. Stovetop repair.

Master Bedroom:

1. Floor repair.
2. Flooring (180 ft²)
3. Wall repair & paint.
4. Ceiling fan installation.

Master Bathroom:

1. Remove garden tub.
2. Remove old shower.
3. Floor repair.
4. Flooring (120 ft²)
5. Install new shower.
6. Wall repair & paint.
